

1 **SEC. 2711. TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR**
2 **BRAC 133 PROJECT UNDER FORT BELVOIR,**
3 **VIRGINIA, BRAC INITIATIVE.**

4 (a) **LIMITATION ON PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION.—**

5 The Secretary of the Army may not take beneficial occu-
6 pancy of more than 1,000 parking spaces provided by the
7 combination spaces provided by the BRAC 133 project
8 and the lease of spaces in the immediate vicinity of the
9 BRAC 133 project until both of the following occurs:

10 (1) The Secretary submits to the congressional
11 defense committees a viable transportation manage-
12 ment plan for the BRAC 133 project.

13 (2) The Secretary certifies to the congressional
14 defense committees that construction has been com-
15 pleted to provide adequate ingress to and egress
16 from the business park at which the BRAC 133
17 project is located.

18 (b) **VIABILITY OF TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT**
19 **PLAN.—**To be considered a viable transportation manage-
20 ment plan under subsection (a)(1), the transportation
21 management plan must provide for the ingress and egress
22 of all personnel to and from the BRAC 133 project site
23 without causing a failing level of service to any local or
24 regional roadway or intersection.

1 (c) INSPECTOR GENERAL REPORT.—Not later than
2 September 30, 2011, the Inspector General of the Depart-
3 ment of Defense shall submit to the congressional defense
4 committees a report evaluating the sufficiency and coordi-
5 nation conducted in reaching a finding of no significant
6 impact associated with the site selection of the BRAC 133
7 project. The Inspector General shall give specific attention
8 to the transportation determinations associated with the
9 BRAC 133 project and review and provide comment on
10 the Secretary of Army’s transportation management plan
11 and adherence to the limitations imposed by subsection
12 (a).

13 (d) BRAC 133 PROJECT DEFINED.—In this section,
14 the term “BRAC 133 project” refers to the proposed of-
15 fice complex to be developed at an established mixed-use
16 business park in Alexandria, Virginia, to implement rec-
17 ommendation 133 of the Defense Base Closure and Re-
18 alignment Commission contained in the report of the Com-
19 mission transmitted to Congress on September 15, 2005,
20 under section 2903(e) of the Defense Base Closure and
21 Realignment Act of 1990 (part A of title XXIX of Public
22 Law 101–510; 10 U.S.C. 2687 note).
