I wanted to send you this note thanking you for taking the time out of your busy schedule on August 6 in order to speak with me about the I-395 Express Lane Terminus. As you know from our conversation and prior correspondence, the formal City Council I-395 opposition to any Terminus within the City of Alexandria (such as at Seminary Road or at Shirlington) remains unchanged and reflects significant resident opposition to any Express Lane access north of Turkeycock Run. I was pleased to learn from you that the Express Lane project is ahead of schedule and that there are no plans for a substitute/additional northern Express Lane Terminus point(s) beyond Turkeycock Run.

The Council, City Staff, and VDOT have worked closely on several projects. In order to maintain that open communication, I ask that you feel free to call upon me or the Transportation Director, Richard Baier, should any project(s) or studies be undertaken concerning the northern terminus of the Express Lanes.
